ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 24, 2009, ACI Industries Realty, LLC (ACI) filed a complaint against Verizon North Inc. (Verizon). In the complaint, ACI alleges that it entered into a transfer agreement whereby Verizon agreed to transfer certain telephone lines and numbers from ACI to a third party. According to ACI, Verizon conducted the transfer improperly, resulting in the disconnection of ACI's telephone service. ACI calculated that it incurred damages and costs totaling \$9,830.31, plus interest, as a result of Verizon's breach of the agreement.
- (2) On March 25, 2009, ACI and Verizon filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. The parties explain that they have settled the issues and that ACI has agreed to dismiss the complaint.
- (3) Being advised that the parties have reached a settlement and wish to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, the joint motion to dismiss should be granted. Pursuant to the joint motion to dismiss, the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, pursuant to the joint motion to dismiss, the complaint filed by ACI is dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,


