(1) On February 5, 2009, Praxair, Inc. (complainant) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). The complainant alleged that CEI confiscated the benefits of the contract for electricity that the complainant had with CEI and deprived the complainant of its rights under the contract.

- (2) On March 27, 2009, the complainant and CEI filed a joint motion to dismiss this case with prejudice. The parties state that they have reached an informal resolution of this matter that fully and finally resolves all of the issues in this proceeding.
- (3) In light of the resolution of the complaint, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.
