The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 2, 2009, Lincoln Electric Company (complainant) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). The complainant stated that CEI notified the complainant that the contract for service entered into between the complainant and CEI would terminate December 31, 2008. The complainant alleged that any attempt by CEI to bill or collect for electric service on a basis other than the basis permitted by the contract would be unreasonable and unlawful.
- (2) On March 27, 2009, the complainant and CEI filed a joint motion to dismiss this case with prejudice. The parties state that they have reached an informal resolution of this matter that fully and finally resolves all of the issues in this proceeding.
- (3) In light of the resolution of the complaint, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.
