The Commission finds:

- (1) By entry dated April 30, 2008, the Commission ordered the Camp Chase Industrial Railroad (CCRA) to install active grade crossing devices at the highway/railroad grade crossing located at Georgesville Road/County Road 26 (518-924P) in Franklin County. The project was to be completed by April 30, 2009.
- (2) On March 25, 2009, and April 6, 2009, CCRA requested an extension until December 31, 2009, to complete this project. CCRA claims that the extension is necessary because of delays in reaching agreement on the lane configuration and the proper signal system at the crossing.
- (3) On April 7, 2009, staff filed a memorandum recommending approval of CCRA's extension request.
- (4) Upon review, good cause exists to grant CCRA's request for a extension of time for completion of the project. Accordingly, CCRA should complete the project by December 31, 2009. Further, during this time period, CCRA should provide monthly progress reports to staff on the status of this project, and staff should continue to monitor this project to ensure the project is completed within the Commission's newly ordered time frame.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That CCRA be granted an extension of time until December 31, 2009, to complete the project. It is, further,
