## The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 6, 2008, Gary Weiss filed a complaint alleging that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) improperly charged him for gas services that he did not request and that were not provided.
- (2) On March 25, 2008, Duke filed an answer denying the material allegations in the complaint.
- (3) At various times since the answer was filed, settlement conferences and discussions between the parties were held in order to resolve this matter. By entry of January 20, 2009, this matter was scheduled for hearing on February 19, 2009, which was thereafter continued to April 14, 2009.
- (4) In advance of the hearing, the parties informed the attorney examiner that they had resolved this matter. On May 19, 2009, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss that indicated all issues had been resolved. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.

ORDERED, That the complaint be dismissed. It is, further,
