CGC -- GASCO

TRANSITION PLAN

1. Day 1 - Commission approves Joint Application for Transfer of Assets and Customers.
2. Day 2 – Meet with Commission Staff to finalize Notice to be sent to Subject Consumers by mail.
3. Day 3 Meeting between GASCO and CGC to review GASCO's records to see if any of the Subject Consumers have special service or medical conditions listed. If so address those cases individually.
4. Day 10 – GASCO to send out Notice requesting Subject Consumers to become members of CGC, and advising them of a public meeting and a phone number the Subject Consumers can call for more information or to answer questions. The Notice will indicate that if Subject Consumers do not elect to become members of CGC, they will be disconnected from the natural gas lines by no later than Day 60 (two months). Such Subject Consumers who elect not to become members of CGC will have no further claim for service either against GASCO or CGC. Those who receive notices and elect to become members of CGC will promptly receive membership materials and be invited to membership meetings
5. Within two to three weeks of the mailing of the Notice, CGC will conduct a public meeting within the Subject Consumers territory. Representatives of CGC and GASCO will be present to explain the transaction to Subject Consumers and answer questions.
6. Day 11 to Day 60 – Respond to telephone and mail requests for information and assist Subject Consumers to sign up to become members of CGC.
7. Day 60 - Transition period ends. Those Subject Consumers who do not elect to become members of CGC will be disconnected.
