The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Bryan Passick (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-16(B), O.A.C., a prehearing conference was held on May 5, 2009, however the parties were unable to resolve this matter.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-19, O.A.C., provides that an evidentiary hearing shall be scheduled within 60 days after the prehearing conference. Accordingly, a hearing should be held on July 21, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 11-F, at the offices of the Commission 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


