MOTION FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4901-1-02(E), Dynalink Communications, Inc. (hereinafter "Dynalink") respectfully requests that the Ohio Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") enter an Order to protect the confidentiality of its financial information submitted as Exhibit J to its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Competitive Telecommunication Services in Ohio.

Dynalink Communications, Inc. is a privately held Corporation and its financial statements are not part of the public record in any jurisdiction. Further, Dynalink submits that its financial information constitutes trade secretes under Ohio law, the disclosure of such information would be detrimental to Dynalink in the competitive telecommunications market as competitors may obtain sensitive financial and business plan information, and non-disclosure of its financial information is consistent with Title 49 of the Ohio Code. Accordingly, Dynalink requests the Commission treat Exhibit J as confidential and not disclose the financial information or any information contained therein to any person not responsible for reviewing its application.
