The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The above-referenced complaint was filed on May 26, 2009. In the complaint, Tri-Pyramid Machining, Inc. (TPM) stated that excess voltage supplied to its building, from May 4, 2009 to May 9, 2009, by The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), caused its machines to be shut down, and resulted in the loss of work orders and possible long-term machine damage. TPM stated that the power was fine on May 11, 2009. Further, TPM indicated that CEI was negligent in its lack of communication about possible voltage problems from the repair of a substation and in not timely addressing TPM's concerns about the excess voltage.
- (2) On June 17, 2009, CEI filed an answer in this matter. In the answer, CEI admits that, in the week of May 4, 2009, it received a number of calls from TPM pertaining to high voltage and that the company sent a person out to troubleshoot and attempt to repair the problem. CEI admitted that it informed TPM that the company was working on the problem and that the power was fine on May 11, 2009. CEI denied that it failed to communicate with TPM or that any of its actions were negligent. CEI neither affirmed or denied the other allegations in the complaint, and generally denied any allegations that it did not address in its answer.

- (3) Due to the Commission's stated goal of reducing the number of adversarial proceedings before it, this matter should be scheduled for a settlement conference on August 4, 2009, at 11:00 a.m., in hearing room 11-A, in the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (4) The purpose of the settlement conference is to determine whether this complaint can be informally resolved. The parties should bring with them all documents relevant to this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a settlement conference in Case No. 09-443-EL-CSS be scheduled in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
