## <u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 19, 2009, OHIOTELNET.COM, INC. (OHIOTELNET) filed a complaint against Windstream Communications, Inc. and Windstream Ohio, Inc. (Windstream) concerning a billing dispute. With the complaint, OHIOTELNET filed a motion for temporary restraining order. In its motion, OHIOTELNET seeks an order barring Windstream from disconnecting or interfering in any way with the telephone, telecommunications, or broadband services of OHIOTELNET until the Commission decides the merits of the complaint.
- (2) On July 8, 2009, Windstream filed a motion to extend until July 16, 2009, the time for filing a memorandum contra OHIOTELNET's motion for temporary restraining order. In its motion to extend time, Windstream requests an expedited ruling without memoranda and notes that OHIOTELNET's counsel does not object to the issuance of such a ruling.
- (3) Finding no prejudice to any party or undue delay, Windstream's motion to extend the time to respond to OHIOTELNET's motion for temporary restraining order should be granted. Accordingly, Windstream is granted until July 16, 2009, to file a response to OHIOTELNET's motion for temporary restraining order.
- It is, therefore,

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ORDERED, That Windstream is granted until July 16, 2009, to file a response to OHIOTELNET's motion for temporary restraining order. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon the parties, their counsel, and all interested persons of record.
