AKRON Thermal proposes that it be authorized to recover \$4,195.561 in additional annual revenue through an add-on to the monthly demand charge component of its current rates. If the add-on is applied to all tariff customers and to the Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron and Canal Place contract rates, the amount of the temporary adder would be \$4.78 per MWh, which would represent an overall rate increase to customers of 47.8 percent. However, if the add-on is applied to only steam and hot water tariff customers, the amount of the temporary adder would be \$81.49 per MWh, or an overall increase of 71.6 percent.

Changes for providing steam and hot water service to its customers (Case No. 09-453-HT-AEM).
