The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) By entry issued March 23, 2000, the Commission established time periods for filing comments and reply comments regarding FirstEnergy's consumer education plan.
- (2) Finding 5 of that entry indicated that supplemental testimony and intervenor testimony related to the issue of the FirstEnergy consumer education plan did not have to be filed on April 3 and April 10, respectively. The dates referenced should have been April 4 and April 11. In all other respects, the Commission's March 23 entry remains unchanged.
