Galion Perker Project Public Workshop

Wednesday, June 21, 2000 6:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Wilma Crall Elementary School 702 South Boston Street Galion, Ohio

The Galion Peaker Project is an addition of 45 megawatts of electric generating capacity to the facility located approximately 1700 ft. west of South Street, 260 ft. north of Bennington Avenue, and 1600 ft. south of Poplar Street.

Today, thanks to advanced generating and environmental control technologies, plants such as the Galion Peaker Project can provide much needed electricity to support system reliability during times when electricity is most needed and provide a cleaner alternative to older, less environmentally friendly facilities. The project will use natural gas, the cleanest fossil fuel available. Construction is expected to start in the year 2000, and operation is scheduled to meet the high demand in the summer of 2001.

The purpose of the workshop is to provide detailed information on the project and get feedback from the community prior to submitting an application to the Ohio Power Siting Board.
