2. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

Mohawk Utilities, Inc. (herein "Company") is in the process of removing (with customers consent) the customer's yard hydrants which are not in compliance with EPA regulations(OAC 3745-95-09). The yard hydrant is removed at no expense to the customer. The Company would like to be granted permission to change these customers to an availability classification and bill as such. The rate would go from \$13.28 yard hydrant to \$11.81 availability fee. This would eliminate the yard hydrant classification and the Company would remove it from the Company's Tariff.



METHOD OF BILLING

A house on one lot will be charged one residential fee.

A house on one lot and owning one or more unimproved lots at any location will be charged one residential fee and one availability fee for each unimproved lot.

A house and adjoining building structure crossing a common lot line will be charged one residential fee. Adjoining structures on an adjacent lot must complement the residence and render such lot undevelopable as another residence.

A house and adjoining building structure crossing a common lot line and owning one or more unimproved lots at any location will be charged one residential fee and one availability fee for each unimproved lot. An adjoining structure on an adjacent lot must complement the residence and render such lot undevelopable as another residence.

A yard hydrant on one lot will be charged a yard hydrant fee.

A yard hydrant on one lot and owning one or more unimproved lots at any location will be charged one yard hydrant fee and one availability fee for each unimproved lot.

 - (1) The device is acceptable to the public water system to which it will be connected; and
 - (2) All of the backflow and cross-connection requirements of this chapter of the Administrative Code are met.
