ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 30, 2009, Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia), filed an application pursuant to Section 4929.04, Revised Code, for approval of a general exemption of certain natural gas commodity sales services or ancillary services contained in Chapters 4905, 4909, and 4935, Revised Code. In addition, Columbia requests approval of a proposed rider pursuant to Section 4929.11, Revised Code.
- (2) By entry issued August 3, 2009, the attorney examiner granted Columbia's motion for modification of the procedural schedule and extended the deadline for the filing of intervenors' and Staff's direct testimony to August 20, 2009, and the hearing was rescheduled to September 14, 2009.
- On August 10, 2009, Columbia, Staff, Ohio Gas Marketers (3)Group, Dominion Retail, Inc., DTE Energy Trading, Inc., Honda of America Mfg., Inc., National Energy Marketers Association, Northwest Ohio Aggregation Coalition, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Ohio Energy Group, Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy, Ohio Schools Council, ProLiance Energy, LLC, Stand Energy Corporation, and Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. (jointly referred to as the movants), filed a joint motion to modify the procedural schedule. The movants request that the deadline for the filing of intervenors' and Staff's direct testimony be extended from August 20, 2009, to September 3, 2009, and that the hearing be rescheduled from September 14, 2009, to September 28, 2009. The movants explain that they are in ongoing settlement discussions and that no party objects to the proposed modifications to the procedural schedule.

(4) The examiner finds that the movants' request for modification of the procedural schedule is reasonable and should, therefore, be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the movants' joint motion for modification of the schedule in this case be granted, and intervenors' and Staff's direct testimony shall be due on September 3, 2009, and the hearing shall commence on September 28, 2009. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
