ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 13, 2009, Diane Frazier (Ms. Frazier or complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison), alleging that her electrical wires are connected with the residence next door and that her bills have increased.
- (2) Ohio Edison filed an answer on May 5, 2009, asserting that it maintains an account in Ms. Frazier's name for utility service. Ohio Edison denies that Ms. Frazier's electric wires are connected to another residence and adds that charges for Ms. Frazier's service comply with its tariff.
- (3) By entry issued June 8, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for July 21, 2009. The parties participated in the conference but were unable to resolve differences at that time or during the following weeks. During August 2009, Ms. Frazier informed the attorney examiner that she desired to proceed to a hearing.
- (4) This matter is scheduled for a hearing on September 23, 2009, at 10:00 A.M. Eastern Daylight Time, Room 11-G, at the Commission offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. Ms. Frazier is reminded that in complaint proceedings, the burden of proof rests with the complainant. Therefore, at the hearing, it shall be Ms. Frazier's responsibility to appear and be prepared to present evidence in support of her complaint.

- (5) Any party intending to present direct, expert testimony should comply with Rule 4901-1-29(A)(1)(h), Ohio Administrative Code, which requires that all such testimony to be offered in this type of proceeding be filed and served upon all parties no later than seven days prior to the commencement of the hearing.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


