Without waiving or conceding any arguments with respect to the notice provision in R.C. 4903.16, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC") hereby dockets and gives notice to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO" or "Commission") of OCC's intent to file a motion at the Ohio Supreme Court, on or after September 14, 2009, for a stay of the Commission's Entries and Orders in the above-captioned cases. The stay will be directed at preventing the retroactive portion of the rate increase from being collected from AEP Ohio customers. In the absence of a stay, the Commission's Orders granting AEP Ohio retroactive rate increases will irreparably harm AEP Ohio's residential customers.
