ENTRY

The Commission finds:


- (1) On December 19, 2008, John A. Bell d/b/a John A. Bell, Attorney-at-Law (Mr. Bell) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T), alleging that AT&T changed his telephone service without proper authorization and caused unreasonable billing charges.
- (2) On January 8, 2009, AT&T filed a letter from Mr. Bell, in which he stated that he and AT&T had agreed to a thirty-day extension starting on January 8, 2009, for AT&T to file its answer.
- (3) AT&T filed its answer on April 29, 2009, denying that Mr. Bell did not authorize or receive any notice of a proposed change in service.
- (4) By entries issued on April 30, 2009, and May 21, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled a prehearing conference for June 18, 2009. The parties participated in the conference and continued settlement discussions afterwards.
- (5) On September 1, 2009, AT&T and Mr. Bell filed a joint letter indicating that the complaint had been resolved and can be dismissed.
- (6) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request to dismiss Case No. 08-1313-TP-CSS be granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


