The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 8, 2008, Optimum System Products (Optimum) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T) to dispute the assessment of a contract termination fee.
- (2) AT&T filed an answer to the complaint on September 29, 2008, wherein it stated that it assessed termination liability charges because Optimum terminated the contract before expiration of the contract term.
- (3) By entries issued June 19, 2009, and August 28, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference. The conference took place on September 1, 2009.
- (4) On September 10, 2009, the parties filed a letter advising the Commission that the parties' discussions led to a satisfactory resolution of the complaint. The parties, therefore, jointly request that the complaint be dismissed.
- (5) Upon being advised that the complaint has been resolved to the satisfaction of the parties, the Commission finds that the request to dismiss the complaint should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, pursuant to the request of the parties, the complaint filed in this matter is dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon the complainant, AT&T, its counsel, and all interested persons of record.
