Upon application of Counsel for the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC"), Richard Reineck, Advanced Customer Service Specialist with the Toledo Edison Company is hereby required to appear on October 21, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (180 E. Broad Street, 11th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215), and attend the hearing from day to day until called by OCC and completing his testimony. The witness shall submit to oral testimony by cross-examination by the OCC concerning Mr. Reineck's role participating in, and communicating, Toledo Edison's decision-making in the above-captioned complaint case(s) to Mr. Giesler and Mr. Lemke. The witness shall bring with him the following documents:

- 1) Copies of phone logs or written records of conversations Mr. Reineck had with Mr. Lemke and/or Jerry Giesler concerning their respective interconnection agreements and net energy metering rider applications.
- 2) Copies of any e-mail communications between Mr. Reineck and Mr. Lemke and/or Jerry Giesler.
- 3) Copies of phone logs or written records of conversations Mr. Reineck had with any First Energy employee concerning the interconnection agreements and net energy metering rider agreements of Mr. Lemke and Mr. Giesler.

- 4) Copies of any e-mail communications between Mr. Reineck and any other FirstEnergy employee concerning the interconnection agreements and net energy metering rider applications of Mr. Lemke and Mr. Giesler.
- 5) Copies of the results of the testing conducted by Toledo Edison on the premises of Lester Lemke and Jerry Giesler on April 3, 2007.
- 6) Copies of the current interconnection agreement and net energy metering rider applications utilized by Toledo Edison. Such copies should include those posted on Toledo Edison's internet site.
- 7) Copies of the internal policies of Toledo Edison regarding the installation of bi-directional meters on the premises of customers entering into interconnection agreements and net energy metering rider applications with Toledo Edison.
- Copies of tariffs or other documents that provide the cost of the bidirectional meters referenced above.
- Oppies of any documents that indicate the number of residential customers in Toledo Edison territory who have installed windmill generators, which resulted in the execution of interconnection agreements and the approval of net energy metering rider applications.
- 10) Copies of any documents that indicate the number of residential customers in Toledo Edison territory who have installed windmill generators, which resulted in the execution of interconnection agreements and the approval of net energy metering rider applications that were required by Toledo Edison to replace their existing meters with bi-directional meters.
