CASE ID: CCAR0827094U Toledo Edison now has 2 categories for non-usage billing: Residential and non-residential. I feel there should be a 3rd category for agricultural usage. I have one pump with electric provided by Toledo Edison draining my 40 acre field of marginal farmland. My billing with no consumption on January 23, 2009 was \$9.09 (see Attachment A). My latest billing on August 24, 2009 with no consumption was \$25.94 (see Attachment B). This is a significant increase.

My rate at Toledo Edison is the same as for factories and commercial uses. I feel they should bill me at the residential rate or establish a third category for agricultural use.

Please note that the name Harley Miller also appears on my bills. He was the previous owner and has been deceased for many years, but Toledo Edison still prints his name on their billings.

ANSWER

1. Respondent Toledo Edison Company ("Toledo Edison"), for its Answer to the Complaint of Charles F. Carr ("Complainant");¹

FIRST DEFENSE

2. Admits that Toledo Edison is a public utility, as defined by R.C. 4905.03(A)(4), and is duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio.

3. Admits that Complainant is a customer of Toledo Edison who takes electric service at 6057 W. Fritchie Road; Port Clinton, Ohio 43452.

4. Admits that Complainant currently takes service under Toledo Edison's General Service – Secondary tariff. Toledo Edison avers that given Complainant's service profile, this tariff is the most advantageous for Complainant. Toledo Edison further avers that Complainant's property at the 6057 W. Fritchie Road address is not eligible for service under Toledo Edison's residential tariff because that property is not a residence.
