- (1) On September 14, 2009, Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (FirstEnergy) filed an application to establish or amend its inspection, maintenance, repair, and replacement programs for its transmission and distribution lines. Revisions to the application were filed by FirstEnergy on September 15, 2009.
- (2) Paragraphs (E) and (F) of Rule 4901:1-10-27, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), provide that if a filing to establish, or to revise or amend, the electric utility's and transmission owner's inspection, maintenance, repair, and replacement programs is not acted upon by the Commission within 45 calendar days after it is filed, the programs are deemed automatically approved upon the 46th day after the filing date.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that, in order that the Commission and its staff may further review this matter, this application should be suspended until the Commission specifically orders otherwise.
