ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 6, 2009, Thomas M. Poulton filed a complaint against Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) alleging that DP&L wrongfully withheld a security deposit from his monthly service payments.
- (2) On October 7, 2009, Mr. Poulton and DP&L filed a joint notice of dismissal. In the notice, the parties stated that a settlement has been reached in this case and that the complainant voluntarily dismisses this action.
- (3) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


