My name is Robin Dushane and I serve the Eastern Shawnee Tribe, a federally recognized tribe, as the Director of the Cultural Preservation Department. It has been brought to my attention that Everpower Wind Holdings is currently involved in constructing a wind generation facility in Urbana, Ohio.

The mission of this department is to protect burials of our people in their aboriginal homeland. We are most concerned for the protection of undocumented mounds in the area of this specific project. If at all possible I would appreciate answers to the following questions.

Are federal funds being used to construct this facility? Are federal grants being used to offset the cost of building the Buckeye Wind Project? Could you supply me with the Project Number pertaining to its license from the Federal Department of Energy?
