#### GRADE OF SERVICE LIMITATIONS

- 5.01. In compliance with Part 4901:1-5-04 of the Code of Rules and Regulations of The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, applications for service regrades, moves, and changes shall not be accepted for:
  - A. Business service exceeding an individual line.
  - B. Residence service exceeding four-party service within any base rate area, except that when the number of subscribers having four-party service in the base rate area of any exchange is less than five per cent of the subscribers in such area or when the Commission finds upon application, complaint or its own motion that the continued offering of four-party service is no longer viable then no applications for service, regrades, moves and changes shall thereafter be accepted for residence service exceeding two-party service within that area. The remaining residence four-party service in such base rate area may thereafter, with the approval of the Commission, be upgraded to a higher grade of service.

#### 4. LIFELINE ASSISTANCE

#### 4.01. General

Lifeline Assistance is a federal support program that provides eligible customers with the following benefits:

- A recurring discount equal to the maximum contribution of federally available assistance will be applied to the
  monthly basic local exchange service charge; at no time should the discounts cause the monthly basic local
  exchange rate to be less than zero.
- A waiver of the Federal Subscriber Line Charge.
- A waiver of the Federal Universal Service Charge.
- A waiver of the state Access Recovery Charge.
- Customers have the option to purchase call waiting and an option to purchase other features for medical and/or safety reasons per O.A.C. 4901:1-5 and other applicable Commission rules and Orders.
- Free blocking of toll and 900/976 dialing patterns, upon customer's request.
- A waiver of the Telephone Company's service deposit requirement.
- A credit of one hundred percent (100%) of all nonrecurring service order charges for commencing service excluding
  jacks and wiring charges.

Where an increase to basic local exchange service rates arises from the determination that a specific exchange is competitive, Verizon Lifeline Assistance customer accounts will be credited for the same amount as the increase so as to offset that increase.
