The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 14, 2009, Sharon L. Wilson filed a complaint against Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy) alleging that charges from Duke Energy are unjust and unreasonable, that Duke Energy provided inadequate service, and that Duke Energy failed to follow Commission rules and regulations.
- (2) On November 3, 2009, Ms. Wilson filed a letter advising the Commission that a settlement has been reached with Duke Energy. Further, Ms. Wilson requested that the complaint be dismissed.
- (3) In view of the settlement of the complaint, this case should be dismissed.

ORDERED, That this case is dismissed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


