ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 11, 2009, David Barrickman (complainant) filed a complaint against the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleging that the company erred by misdirecting his residential billing notices to his unoccupied rental property, leading to nonpayment of the bill and subsequent disconnection of electric service at his residence.
- (2) A settlement conference was held on October 29, 2009.
- (3) On November 13, 2009, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss, explaining that they have settled the issues raised in the complaint. The parties, therefore, request that the Commission dismiss the complaint with prejudice.
- (4) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 09-496-EL-CSS be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon the complainant, the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and its counsel, and all interested persons of record.




