APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF AN AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1996

GoldStar Communications, LLC ("GoldStar") hereby files the attached agreement dated November 17, 2009 ("the Agreement") between GoldStar and Telephone Service Company ("TSC") ("the Parties") for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to the provisions of Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Pub. L. No. 104-104, 110 Stat. 56 (1996) (codified at 47 U.S.C. 151 et. seq.) ("the Act"). This filing is made pursuant to the Act.

The Agreement is filed pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 252(e) of the Act.

Under Sections 252(e)(1) and (2), the Commission must approve the Agreement unless the

Agreement or a portion thereof "... discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a

party to the agreement" or "... implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent

with the public interest, convenience, and necessity." The Agreement does not discriminate

against other telecommunications carriers. The Agreement is in the public interest, convenience

and necessity because it sets forth the Parties' respective obligations and the terms and

conditions under which they will interconnect their networks and facilities.

In accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Act, the Agreement will be deemed approved if the Commission does not act to approve or reject the Agreement within 90 days from the date of this Application.

WHEREFORE, GoldStar Communications, LLC requests that the Commission approve the Agreement.

AGREEMENT OF ADOPTION

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. AGREEMENT OF ADOPTION

By GOLDSTAR (OH)'s countersignature below, GOLDSTAR (OH) hereby adopts and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Interconnection between Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") and TSC effective September 30, 2008 (the "Adopted Agreement") as that agreement exists on the date hereof and as amended herein. The Adopted Agreement was approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") in Case No. 08-1157-TP-NAG.

As the terms and conditions of the Adopted Agreement are being adopted by GOLDSTAR (OH) pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Act, TSC does not provide such terms and conditions to GOLDSTAR (OH) as either a voluntary or negotiated agreement. TSC's performance of the Agreement does not in any way constitute a waiver by TSC of any position as to the Agreement or a portion thereof, nor does it constitute a waiver by TSC of all rights and remedies it may have to seek review of the Agreement, or to seek review in any way of any provisions included in the Agreement as a result of GOLDSTAR (OH)'s adoption.

All services provided under this Agreement will be consistent with the decisions of the Federal Communications Commission, the Commission, and the courts having jurisdiction over this Agreement.

2. PARTIES:

GOLDSTAR (OH) is hereby substituted in the Adopted Agreement for Sprint Communications Company L.P. and/or Sprint and TSC shall remain as the other Party (the "ILEC") to the Adopted Agreement. Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall in all other respects reflect the same terms as the Adopted Agreement.

3. TERM:

The Agreement will become effective upon execution of both Parties with the date of the second signature (the "Effective Date"), and, unless earlier terminated in accordance with its terms, will continue in force until September 30, 2010, which corresponds with the expiration of the Adopted Agreement. GOLDSTAR (OH) shall file this Agreement with the Commission promptly upon receipt of the Agreement countersigned by TSC.
