<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 1, 2009, Pyrotecnico (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 490l:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) A prehearing conference was conducted on September 18, 2009, but the parties were unable to reach settlement. By entry issued on September 23, 2009, a hearing date of December 3, 2009, was scheduled.
- (3) On October 27, 2009, staff filed a letter stating that during an October 8, 2009, telephone call, Respondent informed staff that it would not challenge the violations recorded during a September 12, 2008, inspection of Respondent's vehicle. The letter also stated that upon receiving payment of the civil forfeiture from Respondent, staff would seek dismissal of the case.
- (4) On November 13, 2009, staff filed a letter stating that Respondent had paid the civil forfeiture in full and requesting dismissal of the case.
- (5) Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C., provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (6) Given that Respondent has paid the forfeiture, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
