ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) The hearing in this matter was originally scheduled on December 1, 2009, but was continued until December 10, 2009, because the respondent, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, had a scheduling conflict on the hearing date.
- (2) On December 7, 2009, counsel for Tri-Pyramid Machining, Inc. filed a notice of withdrawal as counsel of record. In the notice, counsel stated that he is withdrawing as complainant's counsel because he has been suspended by the Ohio Supreme Court for 18 months, with six months of the suspension stayed on conditions. Counsel stated that this suspension is effective as of December 2, 2009. Further, counsel requested that additional time be allowed to enable the company to engage new counsel.
- (3) In view of the circumstances, the request to continue the hearing should be granted.
- (4) The hearing in this matter should be rescheduled on January 26, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time, in conference room 1247, in the offices of the Commission, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be rescheduled for hearing in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
