The Commission finds:


- (1) On September 16, 2009, the Ohio State Legislative Board, United Transportation Union (UTU) filed a complaint against Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) alleging that NS has permitted unsafe and hazardous walking and tripping conditions to exist at its facilities.
- (2) On October 16, 2009, NS filed an answer to the complaint. On February 1, 2010, staff filed a memo indicating that this matter had been resolved. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

ORDERED, That the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,




