MOTION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT BY MATERIAL SCIENCES CORPORATION

Pursuant to ORC 4903.221, and Rule 4901-1-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code, Material Sciences Corporation ("MSC") moves the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") for leave to intervene in these proceedings as a full party of record. MSC's intervention should be granted because it has a real and substantial interest that is not represented by an existing party; its participation will not cause undue delay, will not unjustly prejudice any existing party, and will contribute to the just and expeditious resolution of issues in this proceeding. Incorporated by reference is the Memorandum In Support of this motion. Wherefore, MSC requests that the Commission, its legal director,

the deputy legal director, or the attorney examiner assigned to these matters, grant intervention to Material Sciences Corporation in this proceeding as a full party of record.

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Pursuant to ORC 4903.221, and Rule 4901-1-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code, Material Science Corporation ("MSC") moves the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") for leave to intervene in these proceedings as a full party of record. The primary business of MSC's Walbridge Coatings in Walbridge, Ohio is electro galvanizing or zinc-nickel plating of steel coils, laminating of steel coils, and painting of steel coils. The MSC Walbridge facility incurs annually substantial electric costs for service from The Toledo Edison Company ("TE").

In these proceedings, the Companies¹ request Commission approval of their 2010-2012 portfolio plans for offering energy efficiency and peak demand reduction programs, to recover associated costs, and of their initial EE&PDR benchmark reports.

RC 4903.221 and OAC Rule 4901-1-11 set standards for intervention in Commission proceedings. MSC, a TE Standard Service Offer customer receiving interruptible service, purchases substantial energy usage, and incurs substantial electric costs. MSC has a real and substantial interest not represented by an existing party in these proceedings that request Commission approval of a Request for Proposal interruptible service process intended to replace the current riders for service after May 31, 2011. Intervention is necessary for MSC to protect those real and substantial interests by raising objections and participating in the hearings.

The Commission granted MSC intervention in the Companies MRO and ESP

proceedings, Case No. 08-935-EL-SSO, and Case No. 08-936-EL-SSO; and their fuel

rider proceeding, Case No. 09-21-EL-ATA. More recently, the Commission granted

MSC's intervention in the Companies' MRO case, Case No. 09-906-EL-SSO. The MRO

case raised initially the Companies plan to use the RFP process in lieu of the current

riders for interruptible services.

MSC's participation in these proceedings will not cause undue delay, will not

unjustly prejudice any existing party, and will contribute to the just and expeditious

resolution of raised issues.

MSC, with a real and substantial interest in these proceedings, timely files for

intervention by February 16, 2010, as provided for the Entry, dated January 14, 2010, and

is otherwise entitled to intervention under ORC 4903.221, and OAC 4901-1-11.

Wherefore, Material Sciences Corporation requests that the Commission, its legal

director, the deputy legal director, or the attorney examiner assigned to these matters,

grant the motion to intervene in this proceeding as a full party of record.
