ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) The Attorney Examiner notes that E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company (DuPont, complainant) and Columbus Southern Power Company (CSP, respondent) have participated in two settlement conferences in an effort to resolve the issues raised in DuPont's complaint. However, the Attorney Examiner notes that the conferences were held on July 23, 2009, and September 2, 2009, and the most recent update of the status of negotiations filed in the docket was received on October 22, 2009. Given that it has been almost four months since the Commission was updated on the status of the negotiations, the Attorney Examiner directs the parties to file a status report with the Commission by March 5, 2010. Further, the parties are directed to continue to update the Commission on the status of negotiations, by filing a letter in the docket every 90 days thereafter (i.e., June 3, September 1, November 30, 2010, etc.) until the parties have resolved the dispute or notify the Commission that negotiations have stalled and a hearing must be scheduled.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties file a letter in the docket updating the Commission on the status of negotiations as set forth above. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon DuPont and its counsel, CSP and its counsel, and all other interested persons of record.
