Notes: I would like to know why you folks still hold the positions of trust that you do. I was a "J" rate CEI customer since 1972, and was promised I would have this rate as long as I remained "all electric". CEI broke their promise to me, increasing my bill >60%, I'm on a fixed income, and YOU let this predatory practice happen. I thought your purpose was to insure fair and reasonable actions by the utilities. "IT AIN'T HAPPENING!!!!!" You are underwriting CEI breaking a contract with me. The rates you are telling me about may seem trivial to you, but to people on fixed incomes, or are not getting pay increases, because of the economy, these rate increases could be catastrophic. In some cases, increasing their bills by greater than 100%. I paid 1.9 cents/kwhr in Jan. 2009. This Jan. 5 cents/kwhr. Is this a fair increase in your mind? IF it is, all the commissioners that feel that way should be removed from the commission. I'm begining to feel that the electric utilities have the commission in their pocket.
