Notes: Back in 2007, I invested nearly \$15,000 to change my home over to an all electric house so that I could qualify for the Total Electric Rate. I purchased two electric heat pumps and a 80 gallon electric hot water tank. I spoke with Ohio Edison prior to making the investment and they insured me that I would be locked in at the reduced rate for as long as I own my house.

Low and behold, without any notice in written or oral form, one day last year I lost my rate and I was changed over to the standard rates system. Since then, my consumption has fallen over last year, but my bills have more than doubled. As far as I am concerned - this is criminal on behalf of Ohio Edison as well as yourselves in allowing this to happen. When you make a representation that this is a fixed rate and incent people to make an investment in new technology, I would expect you to hold the utilities feet to the fire. This is so typical of our current government structure that is in bed with the large companies. I am actively seeking to join any lawsuits in this case. If we had done this in our business, the marketplace would shut us down. Please take a look into this matter. I am sure many others have been screwed by this matter
