ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On January 29, 2010, Avon Lake Solar 1, LLC (Avon Lake), Scioto Valley Solar One, LLC (Scioto Valley One), and Scioto Valley Solar Two, LLC (Scioto Valley Two) filed applications for certification as eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facilities. Scioto Valley Two filed an amended application on February 26, 2010.
- (2) Pursuant to the terms of Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code, these applications are subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. The rule also provides that the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval process.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review these applications. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for these applications for certification, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review these matters.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the applications of Avon Lake, Scioto Valley One, and Scioto Valley Two for certification as eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facilities be suspended. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in these cases.
