It received all new wiring, new insulation, new insulated walls, new energy efficient appliances, the list goes on. This does not seem legitamate and when I contacted Ohio Edison, they basically said too bad, yes your cost is on the high side for what you are doing but your house used that much electric so you must pay it. This seems ridiculous.
