Notes: I closed on an all-electric home-sale in January 2007 . I understand that the all-electric discount was discontinued at this time except for those grandfathered in. Do I have an arguement since my home purchase was in negotiations when this discount was discontinued? How are those of us that purchased or closed on a home sale after December 31, 2006 affected by the recent reinstatement of the all-electric discount. Why were these discounts stopped to new homeowners after December 31, 2006? It certainly seems unfair to me that I missed closing on my home by a mere 16 days (by no fault of mine) and thus was shut out of a discount. Why were some (those grandfathered) allowed to continue with their discount but new home buyers not allowed. The all-electric discount was much of my decision when I purchased the home. But when the closing date passed 12-31-2006 I was out of luck. I was told by the Illuminating Company in January 2007 that I did not qualify for the discount. Why have we new homeowners been excluded from the discount?
