Dear PUCO:


I recently received my January billing from the Illuminating Company. I wanted to share with you the largest outright theft I have ever witnessed. Thanks to your rulings, my electric bill, on a per KWH basis, has risen 88.79% compared to the January 2009 billing.

Enclose you will find copies of my 2009 & 2010 statements along with a spreadsheet showing the computations on the cost increases. I do not understand what you were thinking in allowing the deregulation to occur in this fashion. It is the equivalent of outright rape!

My wife and I are retired and on fixed income. I have no way of increasing my monthly income by 88%.

Copies of this correspondence are being sent to The Illuminating Company and to my State Senator Tim Grendell. With the exception of Senator Grendell, I doubt that you or the Illuminating Company will bother to respond.
