Notes: I want to be included in the emergency PUCO ruling reinstating all-electric rates as I have been left out as I purchased my home after Jan 1, 2007. My home was purchased in the fall of 2008 knowing that I purchased this house w/ the understanding of it being all-electric that the rates were controlled due to an agreement between Bob Schmidt Homes and the electric company.

I ask that you please file this in the docket for Case No. 10-176-EL-ATA.

I am generally upset with the rate increases. My February soared to \$469.92 and then the whopper of March at \$1176.40. I will also tell you that my home has only one adult living in it and I am at work for at least 10.5 hours of the day and another 8 hours sleeping leaving about 5.5 hours that would use extra electricity such as the stove, microwave, tv, radio and extra lights. My heating has been set at 65 degrees since November and I have not upped it any higher to cause such a drastic increase as I was billed. I was able to get my March billing reduced to \$344.42 but that is still very high from what they were.

I want the rates permanently reinstated and attached to the house and not the homeowner so that I should I need to sell my house in the future there will no issues to transfer the discount onto the new buyer. Thank you for taking the time to read my complaint.
