EXHIBIT C – DESCRIPTION OF FILING

This filing is being made to increase the rates of the residential access lines that were granted BLES Alt Reg pricing flexibility. The areas that will see the price increase are outlined in the attached Exhibit D.

EXHIBIT D - CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) is increasing its flat rate residence line (1FR) monthly prices by \$1.25, effective March 15, 2010, in areas where BLES alt reg has been approved. (BLES alt reg is effective in CBT's Bethany, Cincinnati, Clermont, Harrison, Little Miami, Newtonsville, and Williamsburg exchanges.) In accordance with the customer notice requirements in 4901:1-6-16 (B) and 4901:1-4-11 (E), CBT began sending the following bill messages on February 1, 2010 to customers whose 1FR prices will increase. While the tariff will be effective March 17, the new prices will not apply to an individual account until the beginning of the customer's first bill cycle after the price increase is effective. Cincinnati Bell will not bill fractional charges to customers for the period from March 17 until their next bill is processed, thus the March 17 date is not explicit in the notice. This is the same format and process that CBT used for previous 1FR monthly price change notices in BLES alt reg areas.
