## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 26, 2010, Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) filed an application requesting an adjustment to its Infrastructure Replacement Program Rider (Rider IRP) and the Demand-Side Management Rider (Rider DSM), consistent with the Commission's December 3, 2008, order approving the stipulation in In the Matter of the Application of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., for Authority to Amend Filed Tariffs to Increase the Rates and Charges for Gas Distribution Service, Case No. 08-72-GA-AIR, et al. (Columbia Distribution Rate Case).
- (2) By entry issued March 5, 2010, the attorney examiner, inter alia, established the procedural schedule in this case. Specifically, Columbia was directed to file a statement, informing the Commission whether the issues raised in comments have been resolved by April 5, 2010. In addition, by entry issued April 2, 2010, the attorney examiner directed that expert testimony should be filed no later than noon on April 7, 2010.
- (3) During a conference with the parties, the parties proposed to the attorney examiner the following alteration to the procedural schedule:
  - (a) The parties will notify the Commission by noon on April 6, 2010, if all of the issues raised in comments have been resolved.
  - (b) The parties will file expert testimony by the close of business on April 8, 2010.
- (4) Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that the procedural schedule in this case should be modified, as agreed to by the parties and set forth in finding (3).

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' request for an alteration of the procedural schedule be granted and that the procedural schedule set forth in finding (3) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
