Pursuant to my entry of February 26, 2010, this matter was scheduled for an evidentiary hearing as well as a public hearing, which was held on March 18th of last week, 2010. It is my understanding at this point in time that the parties have been in discussion with respect to a potential stipulation in this matter and are interested in pursuing a call and continue of this hearing until April 7th of 2010.

MR. YURICK: That's correct, Your Honor.

HEARING EXAMINER AGRANOFF: I also understand, based on prior conversations with counsel, that it is OCC's desire that they have the opportunity within one week subsequent to the entry of the Joint Stipulation to file a supporting brief.

MS. YOST: That's correct, Your Honor.

HEARING EXAMINER AGRANOFF: And to the extent that any of the other two parties have any desire to file a pleading in response to OCC's brief, they may do so within five business days of that filing. If there's nothing else, then we will be in recess until the 7th of April. Thank you.
