## **ENTRY**

## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and the Toledo Edison Company (FirstEnergy) are public utilities as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, are subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On March 23, 2010, FirstEnergy filed an application, pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code, for a standard service offer for the period between June 1, 2011, and May 31, 2014. This application is for an electric security plan (ESP), in accordance with Section 4928.143, Revised Code, and the application includes a stipulation agreed to by various parties regarding the terms of the proposed ESP.
- (3) By entry dated March 24, 2010, the attorney examiner issued a procedural schedule for this proceeding. Under the procedural schedule, testimony by intervenors and Staff is due to be filed on April 13, 2010.
- (4) Subsequently, on April 7, 2010, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) and FirstEnergy filed a joint motion for an extension of time to file testimony and request for expedited ruling. In the joint motion, OCC and FirstEnergy request that the due date for intervenor and Staff testimony be extended from April 13, 2010, to April 15, 2010.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds that the joint motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, testimony by intervenors and Staff should be filed no later than April 15, 2010.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion for an extension of time to file testimony be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That testimony on behalf of intervenors and Staff be filed no later than April 15, 2010. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.
