ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 26, 2010, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) filed an application requesting an adjustment to its Accelerated Main Replacement Program (AMRP) rider (Rider AMRP), consistent with the Commission's May 28, 2008, order approving the stipulation in *In the Matter of the Application of Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., for an Increase in Rates*, Case No. 07-589-GA-AIR, et al., (*Duke Distribution Rate Case*).
- (2) By entry issued April 2, 2010, the attorney examiner, *inter alia*, established the procedural schedule in this case. Specifically, the attorney examiner directed that expert testimony should be filed no later than noon on April 14, 2010.
- (3) On April 13, 2010, Duke filed correspondence requesting that the deadline for the filing of expert testimony be extended to April 16, 2010, at 2 p.m. In support of its request, Duke states that all of the parties to this case support the request.
- (4) Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that the request to modify the procedural schedule is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, expert testimony shall be due by at 2 p.m. on April 16, 2010.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Duke's request for an alteration of the procedural schedule be granted and that the procedural schedule set forth in finding (4) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
