ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (FirstEnergy or the Companies) are public utilities as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, are subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On April 15, 2010, the Commission issued its Second Entry on Rehearing in this proceeding. In the Second Entry on Rehearing, the Commission directed FirstEnergy to file revised tariffs that are consistent with the Finding and Order as clarified by the Commission in the Second Entry on Rehearing. The Commission further directed FirstEnergy to file the revised tariffs by April 22, 2010.
- (3) On April 16, 2010, FirstEnergy filed a motion for an extension of time to file the revised tariffs. FirstEnergy contends that additional time is necessary to complete the programming changes to its computer systems in order to implement the Commission's directives. Accordingly, FirstEnergy requests that the deadline for filing revised tariffs be extended to May 7, 2010.
- (4) Given the circumstances surrounding this motion, the attorney examiner will grant a seven-day extension of the deadline for filing revised tariffs while the Commission considers FirstEnergy's request for an extension of time to May 7, 2010.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy's motion for an extension of time be granted, to the extent set forth in Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
