#### **EXHIBIT** A

#### **Service Description**

The purpose of this filing is to advise the Commission that Allied Wireless Communications Corporation d/b/a Alltel ("AWCC") intends to provide facilities-based Commercial Mobile Radio Service ("CMRS") in certain cellular market areas ("CMAs") in Ohio. AWCC will offer pre- and post-paid plans for voice and data services to residents and businesses in Ohio. Customers will be able to obtain service plans and purchase handsets, wireless devices, and accessories through AWCC's retail outlets and its website.

By way of background, AWCC is a direct subsidiary of Atlantic Tele-Network, Inc. ("ATN"). ATN and Verizon Wireless (collectively "the Parties") previously filed applications seeking approval from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") for the assignment and transfer of control of certain wireless licenses and related authorizations from Verizon Wireless to a holding company, Adams Divestiture Company LLC ("Adams LLC"), which would then be contributed to AWCC. See FCC Public Notice, Atlantic Tele-Network, Inc. and Verizon Wireless Seek FCC Consent to Assign or Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations, 24 FCC Rcd 9035 (WTB 2009). The FCC required Verizon Wireless to divest these business operations, formerly under the control of ALLTEL Corporation ("ALLTEL"), as a condition of the FCC's approval of the ALLTEL-Verizon Wireless merger. See Applications of Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless and Atlantis Holdings LLC, 23 FCC Rcd 17444 (2008). These assets are currently being used to provide facilities-based CMRS service in Ohio and other states.

With this filing, AWCC affirms that the FCC consented to the divestiture described above on April 20, 2010, and the Parties have consummated the transaction. ATN subsequently caused Adams LLC to be merged into AWCC, with AWCC being the surviving entity. As a result, AWCC now holds wireless licenses for the provision of facilities-based CMRS service in the Lima and Mansfield, Ohio CMAs. In addition, AWCC now indirectly holds the controlling interests in the following limited partnerships that also hold wireless licenses to provide facilities-based CMRS service in Ohio: Ohio RSA 2 Limited Partnership, Ohio RSA #3 Limited Partnership, Ohio RSA 5 Limited Partnership, and the Ohio RSA 6 Limited Partnership.
