I am writing to fully support the Cleveland Clinic language contained in the electric security plan ("ESP") filed by Ohio Edison, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and Toledo Edison on March 23, 2010. The Cleveland Clinic provision in the ESP will enable the organization to make a \$1.4 billion investment at their Main Campus location to meet growing local, regional, national and international demand.
