> Re: Clarifying Recommendation and Stipulation In The Matter of the Application of Aqua Ohio, Inc. for Authority to Increase Rates and Charges in Its Masury Division PUCO Case No. 09-0560-WW-AIR

Dear Ms. Jenkins:

This is to clarify that the rate increases agreed upon by the Parties in the Recommendation and Stipulation in Case Number 09-560-WW-AIR will be imposed for services rendered after the Stipulation and Recommendation is approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. Paragraph 7 of the Recommendation and Stipulation states that rates will be effective with "bills rendered" after Commission approval of the Stipulation. It is not Aqua Ohio's intent to charge customers at the new rate for services rendered prior to Commission approval.

Once the Commission approves the Recommendation and Stipulation, Aqua Ohio will submit revised tariff sheets consistent with the approval order. Assuming Commission approval on May 5, 2010, the Company intends to file these sheets on or about May 6, 2010. Aqua Ohio shall also mail Customer Notices of the increase in rates. These mailings are anticipated to occur on or about May 7, 2010. Customers shall initially see these rate increases on their first bill that reflects May for services provided after May 5, 2010.¹ A copy of the Customer Notice, with confusing references to "bills rendered" deleted and "services rendered" inserted, is attached hereto.

Dear Customer:

On August 7, 2009 the Company filed an Application (Case No. 09-0560-WW-AIR) with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio to increase rates. The increase is to recover the increased capital investments and operating and maintenance expenses incurred since the current rates were established in March 2001. The PUCO granted an increase of \$318,008, or 65.91% of the Company total request on xxxx, 2010. The total rate increase will be phased in over a period of four years. The phased in percentage increase for year 1 will be 28.3%. The phased in percentage increase for year 2 will be 28.3%. The phased in percentage decrease for year 4 will be 21.45% from year 3 levels. Bills will be rendered monthly beginning with bills rendered ______.

The monthly customer charge remains unchanged during the phase-in period.
