COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY'S AND OHIO POWER COMPANY'S COMMENTS IN RESPONSE TO INDUSTRIAL ENERGY USERS-OHIO'S COMMENTS

Columbus Southern Power Company (CSP) and Ohio Power Company (OPCO), collectively AEP Ohio, filed their application in this case on April 14, 2010. On May 21, 2010, Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU) filed a motion to intervene and submitted comments concerning the application. It is clear on the face of IEU's comments, the arguments raised amount to nothing more than a rehash of the same arguments considered and rejected by the Commission through its March 24, 2010 Finding and Order and its May 19, 2010 Entry on Rehearing in Case No. 09-1095-EL-RDR. Though AEP Ohio does not oppose IEU's motion for intervention in this case, AEP Ohio did want to respond to the comments filed by IEU and urges the Commission to reject IEU's arguments once again.

Rather than further burdening this record with a repeat of AEP Ohio's arguments rebutting IEU's comments, AEP Ohio incorporates into this Memorandum Contra its Response to IEU's Comments, filed in Case No. 09-1095-EL-RDR on March 8, 2010, its
